- ⁴ And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die:

⁵ For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil.

⁶ And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.

The result was humanity's nature was fractured to have the mind of the serpent to know good and evil and was about to perpetuate his lie which is spoken 99% of the time at the 'Christian' funeral service. ⁶ Also their love, and their hatred, and their envy, is now perished; neither have they any more a portion for ever in anything that is done under the sun.

Notice the words the thoughts and feelings are no more. There is no thought or feeling or recognition of those things done on earth.



Job 14: 12 So man lieth down, and riseth not: till the heavens be no more, they shall not awake, nor be raised out of their sleep.

¹³ O that thou wouldest hide me in the grave, that thou wouldest keep me secret, until thy wrath be past, that thou wouldest appoint me a set time, and remember me!

¹⁴ If a man die, shall he live again? all the days of my appointed time will I wait, till my change come.

¹⁵ Thou shalt call, and I will answer thee: thou wilt have a desire to the work of thine hands.

The work of God's hands is at the resurrection to restore a perfect mind to those who have perfected character after the likeness of God.

Job 19: ²⁵ For I know that my redeemer liveth, and that he shall stand at the latter day upon the earth:


²⁶ And though after my skin worms destroy this body, yet in my flesh shall I see God:

²⁷ Whom I shall see for myself, and mine eyes shall behold, and not another; though my reins be consumed within me.

The meaning of the words to Handel's Messiah are often missed. Thou worms destroy this body yet in my flesh shall I see God.

Daniel 12 And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time: and at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book.

² And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt.



³ And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever.

⁴ But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, even to the time of the end: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.


Notice when the resurrection happens- at the last days, a time of trouble such as never was, when many shall run to and fro. This is in our time.



Matthew 22:²⁸ Therefore in the resurrection whose wife shall she be of the seven? for they all had her.

- ²⁹ Jesus answered and said unto them, Ye do err, not knowing the scriptures, nor the power of God.
- ³⁰ For in the resurrection they neither marry, nor are given in marriage, but are as the angels of God in heaven.
- ³¹ But as touching the resurrection of the dead, have ye not read that which was spoken unto you by God, saying,
- ³² I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob? God is not the God of the dead, but of the living.
- ³³ And when the multitude heard this, they were astonished at his doctrine.

The Sadducees thought to trick Christ with their questions because they did not believe in the resurrection. Paul says if there is no resurrection from the dead then we of all men are most miserable.



John 11:11 These things said he: and after that he saith unto them, Our friend Lazarus sleepeth; but I go, that I may awake him out of sleep.

- 11:12 Then said his disciples, Lord, if he sleep, he shall do well.
- 11:13 Howbeit Jesus spake of his death: but they thought that he had spoken of taking of rest in sleep.
- 11:14 Then said Jesus unto them plainly, Lazarus is dead.
- 11:21 Then said Martha unto Jesus, Lord, if thou hadst been here, my brother had not died.
- 11:22 But I know, that even now, whatsoever thou wilt ask of God, God will give [it] thee.
- 11:23 Jesus saith unto her, Thy brother shall rise again.
- 11:24 Martha saith unto him, I know that he shall rise again in the resurrection at the last day.
- 11:25 Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:
- 11:26 And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this?
- 11:27 She saith unto him, Yea, Lord: I believe that thou art the Christ, the Son of God, which should come into the world.

In one succinct sentence Maratha who sat at Jesus feet says it all.

- John 20:16 Jesus saith unto her, Mary. She turned herself, and saith unto him, Rabboni; which is to say, Master.
- 20:17 Jesus saith unto her, Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father: but go to my brethren, and say unto them, I ascend unto my Father, and your Father; and [to] my God, and your God.

Notice the words 'My God and your God' (there are three that have divine power the Father, Son and the Holy Ghost but the source of all divinity is the Father) and the comment He had not in death yet ascended to the Father for the dead know not anything.



John 5: 28 Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice,

²⁹ And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.

³⁰ I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me.

John 6: ³⁹ And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.

⁴⁰ And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.

⁴¹ The Jews then murmured at him, because he said, I am the bread which came down from heaven.

Many disciples left him it goes on to say and he turned to the 12 and said will you also leave me? And they answer to whom shall we turn? You have the words of life. To many who followed Him, He offered life yet the majority turned away from Him. That's the insanity of humanity!

¹³ But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope.

¹⁴ For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.

¹⁵ For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep.

¹⁶ For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

¹⁷ Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air; and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

¹⁸ Wherefore comfort one another with these words.

Comfort yourself with what is real not the words of the demon who says you shall not die. Those that believe his lie he then can appear as dead loved ones mimicking their voice and appearance. He has that ability.
